This first page shows storage Ideas for the area around the porta potty location on an older Rhodes (without the "swell head") The porta potty has been removed to show the stowage areas better.

(left) Starbord hull above head. A small paperback book shelf and plastic drawers help with storage.





The area immediately behind the head was just a curved hull. By squaring it off and building a concealed lid a useful and secure storage space is created.





The area under the flip up portion of the settee was not useful. To port a drawer insert from Ikea was secured under the fixed portion of the settee. The cabin sole to port of the head was then opened up with an access hatch. Though the area under is only about 4" deep, by employing an assortment of modified plastic bins it is a great place to store a lot of drinking water bottles.




Under galley storage is always a challenge. above are 2 large plastic drawers secured to the galley counter top. Inexpensive and very useful. Removable "shoeboxes" below.

(Below) two narrow plastic drawers provide storage for galley utensils. Below secured plastic bins organize the dishes etc. Note the "bar type" wine glass holders just forward of the sink.



(Right) Aft port settee had a large "dead" area. This was accessed by making a simple hatch which allowed all sorts of useful space to be accessible.



Narrow area just aft of icebox. A small removable divider secures several 2 liter drink bottles and a small solar charging panel.



Aft port bulkhead, large plastic magazine bin holds all sorts of things. Small suction cup holder is just right for glasses and lotion.
