CERTIFICATE OF SUPPORT PROGRAM

If your Rhodes is for sale, consider the advantages of including a numbered Certificate of Support with your boat. The cost of a General Boats owner's lifetime Certificate of Support is 10% of the selling price.

If you are looking to buy a Rhodes 22 and your budget rules out buying a New Rhodes or a Recycled Rhodes with new boat guarantee, buying a used Rhodes directly from an owner who includes a Certificate of Support, will make the purchase of a used Rhodes much more comfortable. You will have the support of General Boats over the entire time period of your ownership. You will be able to call GB anytime on issues when time is of the essence. You will be able to send e-mail questions and get prompt problem-solving replies. And you will have access to ordering Rhodes parts that are not available from any other source - PROVIDED you give your Certificate number with your calls or mails.

A Rhodes buyer purchasing from a private seller, who cannot supply a numbered Support Certificate, must contact that seller directly for answering any questions and resolving any problems encountered with that particular boat. Needed parts may be ordered from General Boats via mail order at prices that differ from parts pricing offered to Certificate holders.

In order to be assured of General Boats direct ongoing support for a lifetime of Rhodes sailing, as well as valuable assistance when you are ready to sell your Rhodes, if the seller of the boat you are buying can not include a Numbered Support Certificate with that boat, you may want to consider buying your used Rhodes from General Boats or from another owner who can include this valuable Certificate with your purchase.

Used Rhodes purchased direct from General Boats are sold with your being able to turn that used boat in for a new or updated Recycled version with 100% OF THE PURCHASE PRICE OF THE ORIGINAL BOAT APPLIED TO THE PURCHASE OF THE NEWER MODEL. This exclusive General Boats' program effectively allows sailing a Rhodes for up to two years at no cost while deciding if you and your family should move up to a new or recycled "new boat guaranteed model" with all the colors and all the features you now want in your next Rhodes.
