Here is a preview of Sea Prompt's FX-7 Fortress Anchor. It has more than enough holding power for overnighting. It is equivalent to a much heavier Danforth anchor.

Here is the anchor ready to deploy. I use about 3.5 feet of chain. The Red cover is an extra accessory. Since this one disassembles and is easy to store, I don't have the chain attached while it is in storage. This is the reserve anchor until I can afford another Fortress. Then it will be the primary, and the red cover will go to the new reserve.



The Anchor and bag with line and chain are stored on the cabin deck, starboard side near the passageway and the cooler.
