

Rhodes 22 Continential

Sail shows approx .609M (2.0') clew height. This puts sheet near rear of track which should leave plenty of room forward to push lead forward as reefing. Typically you don't want to reef the sail more than the length of the tack reinforcements - \sim 30% of overlap. Combine that shorter foot with the shorter luff length and the effective area is comparable to a 90% Jib.
